Subject: Request for Records

Dear Fran Silverman:

The Division has received your request for records of August 18, 2014 for "...copies of public records regarding any investigations and consumer complaints relating to: Wake Up Now..." Your request has been considered under the *Utah Government Records Access and Management Act* ("GRAMA"), UTAH CODE ANN. §§ 63G-2-101 et seq., as amended. The Division has classified records of complaints received against a particular entity as protected records under UTAH CODE ANN. § 63G-2-305(10), and as private records under UTAH CODE ANN. § 63G-2-302(2)(d). Therefore, I can neither confirm nor deny whether the Division has received any complaints against Wake Up Now. However, I can confirm to you that the Division has not taken any disciplinary action, either administrative or legal, against Wake Up Now.

If you wish to challenge this denial, you may file a Notice of Appeal under UTAH CODE ANN. § 63G-2-401 with the executive director of the Utah Department of Commerce. The notice must be filed within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter and must be addressed to Ms. Francine A. Giani, Executive Director, Utah Department of Commerce, 160 East 300 South, Box 146701, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-6701. Your Notice of Appeal must contain your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number, and some indication of the relief you are seeking. You may also file a brief statement in support of your appeal.
