ORDER

The parties have reached a complete settlement in this case, but the settlement is part of a global settlement agreement involving two other related cases. (Doc. 63 (“**Motion**”).) The parties jointly move to stay this case, pending the final approval and administration of the global settlement in *Smith v. Costa Del Mar, Inc.*, Case No. 3:18-cv-1011-J-32JRK (M.D. Fla.). (*Id.*) The Court will grant the Motion in part—staying the case for ninety days.

It is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED**:

1. The parties’ Join Notice of Settlement and Request for Stay of All Pending Deadlines (Doc. 63) is **GRANTED IN PART**:
 - a. The Motion is **GRANTED** to the extent the action is **STAYED** for ninety (90) days.
 - b. In all other respects, the Motion is **DENIED**.

2. The parties are **DIRECTED** to file a joint status report on or before Friday, **February 28, 2020** and another status report on or before Friday, **March 27, 2020**.
3. The Clerk is directed to **ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSE** the case.
