

ORDER


Before the court are Defendants' Motion to Stay filed December 23, 2019 (Doc. #41); Plaintiff's Response to Defendants' Motion to Stay filed January 6, 2020 (Doc. #51); Plaintiff's Notice of Order and Briefing Schedule from the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals filed January 9, 2020 (Doc. #53); and Defendants' Reply in Support of Defendants' Motion to Stay filed January 13, 2020 (Doc. #55). Having considered the motion, response, and reply, the court concludes that a stay is appropriate in this case pending appeal before the Fifth Circuit on the arbitration question.

On January 8, 2020, the Fifth Circuit granted Defendants' Motion to Expedite Appeal, and argument is tentatively scheduled for April 27, 2020 . The court find that the parties will not be harmed if this case experiences a slight delay until the circuit court can determine the arbitration question. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Defendants' Motion to Stay filed December 23, 2019 (Doc. #41) is **GRANTED TO THE FOLLOWING EXTENT**: this case is **STAYED** pending further order of the court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall immediately advise the court of any action taken by the circuit in this case.
